Assessment checklist for investors on the character of an entrepreneur and the culture they are creating in their companies.

1. Called to Create

- a. Do they have a bold vision and are they intentional about faith integration in their business model?
- b. Are they intentional about creating a faith driven culture in their company?

2. Identify in Christ

- a. Do they regularly spend time in God's word?
- b. Are they engaged & being disciplined as part of a church community?

3. Steward versus Owner

- a. Do they recognise God as the owner of their business?
- b. Are they motivated by grace & gratitude, rather than fear or need for success?
- c. Do they tithe & are generous with their finances?

4. Don't Worship Work

- a. Do they observe at least 24 hours rest each week for themselves?
- b. Do they prioritise time with their spouse & children?
- c. Do they have a regular exercise pattern?

5. Excellence Matters

- a. Do they do their work to the highest standard?
- b. Do they prioritise creating value for their customers?

6. Faithful versus Willful

- a. Do they make decisions prayerfully?
- b. Are they humble to listen to advice & are accountable to others?

7. Ministry in Deed

- a. Do they treat their employees with respect & provide support?
- b. Do they encourage volunteering & giving as part of their company?

8. Ministry in Word

- a. Do they have integrity in word & action?
- b. Do they seek opportunities to share their Gospel hope with gentleness & respect?
